TERMS OF USE

By playing snooker at Norton House Country Club, you are agreeing to these terms and conditions set by the executive committee. Failure to comply may result in: being prohibited from entering the snooker room; being liable for costs to repair or replace equipment; suspension or termination of club membership in accordance with the disciplinary procedure set out in the club rules.

Rules

1. All guests must be signed in and the appropriate member and guest fees paid.
2. Snooker table lights must be on when playing snooker to avoid damaging the tables.
3. Ensure hands are clean before playing.
4. Under 16s must be accompanied by an adult.
5. Only the striker is allowed near the table during their turn. Spectators and opponents should maintain a reasonable distance to avoid interference.
6. Do not sit or climb on the snooker tables. At least one foot must be on the floor at all times.
7. No food is allowed in the snooker room.
8. Keep drinks safe and away from the snooker tables. Drinks must not be placed on any part of the snooker tables.
9. Only the white ball should be struck by the cue.
10. Cues must be in reasonable condition when playing.
11. Any damage to the snooker tables, cloth or equipment must be reported immediately to a member of staff.
12. Do not start any games after 10:30pm.
13. Empty glasses should be returned to the bar.
14. Before leaving, the last player must:
 - a. Ensure all balls are placed back into the box
 - b. Put the cover back on the snooker table
 - c. Return club cues and rests etc to the stands
 - d. Ensure the snooker room door is locked if required
 - e. Return the box of snooker balls and glasses to the bar
